

Frequently Asked Questions

1. What age groups are in Bible Bowl? We will have it broken down into school grade categories: K-1, 2-3, 4-5, 6-8 and 9-12.

2. How will the testing be done for the K-1? We will have these students separated with someone reading each question to them. They will mark an answer on a bubble sheet with help by a proctor if needed. They will have 3 answer choices: A, B or C.

3. How many questions will be given for each written exam?
K-1st grade - 2 sessions of 20 questions each (40 total)
2nd -5th grade – 2 sessions of 35 questions each (70 total)
6th -12th grade – 2 sessions of 45 questions each (90 total)
All answers will be on a standard bubble sheet.

4. What is the format for quick recall?
 1. Single elimination
 2. Matches will be 20 questions.
 3. All 4 players will get 5 questions against a team member from the opposing team.
 4. Teams must be at least 4 members.
 5. If a team has 5 members, we will allow one substitution during the match.
 6. In case of a tie after 20 questions, the team with the next correct answer wins the match.

5. **What** awards will be given?

- A. We will give a participation ribbon for all participants in the 2012 Bible Bowl.
- B. We will give first – fourth place awards for each individual category of written testing.
- C. We will give first and second place awards for quick recall teams.
- D. We will have overall team awards for the top 3 places for each age division on the written test . You must have 4 students in the age group to be eligible for this. If you have more than 4 students, then we will take your top 4 scores.
- E. We will also give an overall top team trophy to the 3 churches that accumulate the most points in awards. The points will be designated as follows:

Written testing – 1st – 5 points: 2nd – 3 points: 3rd - 2 points: 4th – 1 point

Quick Recall - 1st – 10 points : 2nd – 5 points
